Homecoming Court Eligibility Requirements:

1. Each contestant must be a senior in the Fall 2017 semester, no exceptions.
2. Each contestant must have this permission slip signed by your parent/guardian and one teacher.
3. Each contestant must be in good academic standing, passing all subjects.
4. Contestants must wear appropriate clothing to the pep rally, bonfire, dance, and game.
5. No jeans, shorts, gowns, or cocktail dresses are allowed are to be worn on homecoming night. Outfits should not be revealing preferably a pantsuit.
6. All contestants must attend and be on time to all rehearsals, scheduled meetings along with the homecoming activities listed in #4 and dress out days sponsored by Student Council.
7. Any contestant displaying improper conduct that is disrespectful to others will be automatically disqualified from participation.
8. All contestants must adhere to the guidelines stated in the code of conduct for Charleston County Schools and in the James Island Charter High School handbook.

9. All grades and discipline will be verified before the actual school vote. The Homecoming Committee will use grades posted **as of Friday, September 22, 2017**. You will be removed from the court if you do not meet any requirements as outlined on this application.

10. These rules and requirements are effective until October 13, 2017 -Homecoming night.
